National Delivery Plan Implementation Group

Key issues from consultation (YP)

- Starting from a good position
- Age appropriate facilities for young people are a key concern
- Appropriate communication with young people is important
- All young people have different needs
- Care should be planned according to their maturity, rather than age



National Delivery Plan Implementation Group

Key issues from consultation (Parent and Carer)

- NDP and summary not particularly accessible.
- Experiences of poor co-ordination and inconsistency across services.
- Provision of information and support to parents and carers often inconsistent.
- Parents and carers like to be involved and consulted in order to improve services.
- Care should be provided according to the maturity of the child/young person
- Adult wards may be inappropriate settings for some young people due to vulnerability.
